TRAY SIZES



MIX AND MATCH ORDERING



For your convenience, we now produce most of our cultivars rooted in trays of 51 and sold as quantities of 50. This means you can receive twice the varieties as products produced in a 102 tray. Unless otherwise noted, the tray size will be a 51-count tray.

50-COUNT STRIP TRAYS



Although these items are sold in increments of 50, the product is produced in strips of 25-count to allow better spacing on our benches. Items in this tray are indicated with this symbol and include most Begonias, Geraniums and first-year flowering perennials.

SUPER-CELL 50 TRAY



A new tray this year is the Super-Cell 50 Tray with 50 extra-large, round cells measuring 2-inches across and more than 2-inches deep. This allows you to purchase a larger plant for quicker results. This tray is optional for three Cordyline varieties on page 16.

There is only one thing to remember when ordering all of our products (other than Collections): order in increments of 50 per variety, regardless of the tray size!

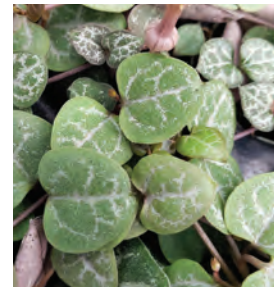

PESTICIDES, BIOLOGICALS & CERTIFICATIONS

Regarding the chemicals we use on young plants during the production process, our MPS certificate encourages us to minimize our use of chemical crop protection agents. One way to accomplish this is to use biological controls when possible. For some pests we have been able to be pesticide free. Pesticides and fungicides we use most frequently have a lower residual, making it easier to introduce beneficial insects at the finish stage.

You are welcome to call and speak to one of our growers regarding the pesticides we currently apply: 603-783-9561.

Disclaimer: Pest control is still our main focus. We can never be sure what pest is on the horizon, or what the next pesticide is coming to the market, nor can we be sure what pesticide has been used by one of our unrooted cutting suppliers.

D.S. Cole Growers' Certifications:

-MPS ABC: This certification helps us monitor and make adjustments to our inputs to reduce our environmental impact. Our score tells us when we are improving and in which categories we may be doing better or may need to improve.

-USDA GAP (Good Agricultural Practices): This certificate is achieved and audited yearly. Practices include the safe handling of crops and worker hygiene.

-SANC (Systems Approach to Nursery Certification): This ensures that a producer is using a holistic approach to reduce pest risks associated with plant trade. It is a new program initiated by the National Plant Board to provide a producer the ability to transport plants throughout all of the United States under its umbrella.

Minimums: Minimum Per Shipment is 600 plants. This replaces our past procedure of calculating by tray count.

Below Minimum Charge: If it is necessary to order less than 600 plants per shipment, a \$10 charge will be applied.

Multiples/Variety: All products should be ordered in multiples of 50 cells.

Late Orders: We define "Late Orders" as those orders that we receive any day of the week prior to the shipping week. It also includes those received by noon on Monday of the actual ship week. We do not charge a "Below minimum charge" on these orders.

Order Changes: Any product additions or a change to the Ship Via to existing orders must happen by the Wednesday prior to the ship week.

Cancellations: No cancellations after the product has been stuck.

Filling Boxes: Determining how to fill boxes can be a challenge due to the nature of our products. We have a number of box sizes available to make most combinations of varieties fit well without wasted space. In general, it is best for an entire shipment to total numbers in even hundreds, rather than 50s. For example, space is typically better utilized when the plant quantity is 1200, 1300 or 1400 rather than 1250, 1350 or 1450.

Packing Charges: Box charges apply only when packaging is needed. Example, trays that travel on shipping carts on our trucks will have no box charge. Trays that require packing for pick-ups, will have a box charge. We pack according to our best knowledge of the weather conditions during transit. There is no extra charge for "winter pack."

Tray Size: a) "Strip Tray 50" - ordered and invoiced at 50, includes most Begonias, Geraniums, Alstroemeria, Gerbera, Echinacea, Helleborus, Rudbeckia and Mandevilla.

b) "Super Cell 50" - this tray has extra large cells, is ordered and invoiced at 50, optional for 3 Cordyline varieties.

c) All other items (other than some collections) are rooted in 51 count trays and billed as 50.

Tags: IMPORTANT NOTE: Tags are now optional. There is a separate and additional charge for tags. We ship tags with every plant unless told otherwise. If you don't want to receive tags, please let us or your broker know.

Royalties: Royalties are included in the price where applicable.

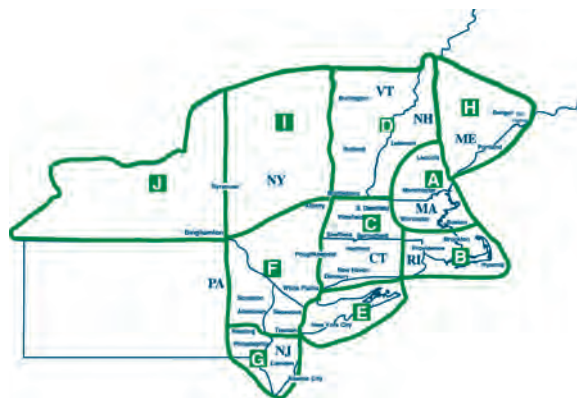
